

School Supplies 2011-2012

As you prepare for the 2011-2012 school year, please use the following supply lists. We have created a basic supply list and an advanced supply list. The basic supply list is the minimum requirement for all students. The advanced supply list is for those students enrolled in our “Advanced” program at West Valley Junior High.

Basic Supply List for 2011-2012 School Year West Valley Junior High

**Individual teachers may require additional supplies, so please make sure to read all course syllabi at the beginning of the year.*

Here are the school supplies you will need:

- ___ One large 2-3” binder (zippered or Velcro recommended)
- ___ college ruled notebook paper (buy at least three packs for the year)
- ___ Two sets of 5 subject dividers (one set may be divider folders w/ pockets)
- ___ Two sewn composition notebooks (**NO spirals or taped notebooks, please - they fall apart!**)



- ___ 1 package 3 x 5” index cards
- ___ blue or black pens (many) (*just bring a few and leave the rest at home for later in the year*)
- ___ #2 lead pencils MECHANICAL for Math and regular for other courses (*just bring a few and leave the rest at home for later in the year*)
- ___ water-based markers (8+ colors)
- ___ 1 pink pearl eraser (pencil end erasers may also be useful)
- ___ tiny hand-held pencil sharpener
- ___ 1 box of colored pencils
- ___ scissors, good quality
- ___ pencil pouch
- ___ One eight pack of AAA batteries (for scientific calculators in math)
- ___ One box of tissues for student use to give to your first period teacher

*Advanced Student 2011-2012 Supplies List West Valley Junior High

Here are the school supplies you will need if you are in the advanced program:

- ___ One large 2-3" binder (zippered or Velcro recommended)
- ___ college ruled notebook paper (buy at least three packs for the year)
- ___ Two sets of 5 subject dividers (one set may be divider folders w/ pockets)
- ___ Three sewn composition notebooks (Two for Language Arts & one for Science [not General Science]), any colors (**NO spirals or taped notebooks, please - they fall apart!**)



- ___ Advanced Science students will need 1 bottle of rubber cement glue (*leave at home until needed in class*)
- ___ 1 package 3 x 5" index cards (*leave at home until needed in class*)
- ___ USB flash drive (at least one GB) fastened to a colorful lanyard or key chain (*leave at home until needed in class*)
- ___ blue or black pens (many) (*just bring a few and leave the rest at home for later in the year*)
- ___ 2-3 colored ink pens (e.g.: green, violet, pink)
- ___ red, fine-tip correcting pens/pencils
- ___ #2 lead pencils NOT MECHANICAL (*just bring a few and leave the rest at home for later in the year*)
- ___ 2-3 highlighters (any colors) (*bring one, leave the rest at home for later in the year*)
- ___ black, **very** fine tipped marker for maps (Pigma[®] Micron[®] 01 archival ink 0.25 mm is perfect - Craft Warehouse)
- ___ water-based markers (8+ colors)
- ___ colored pencils (8+ colors)

- ___ small bottle of school glue & some glue sticks (*small supply at school, the rest at home*)
- ___ 1 pink pearl eraser (pencil end erasers may also be useful)
- ___ white-out
- ___ 2 tape rolls with dispenser (small) (one will be used for your Science notebook)
- ___ tiny hand-held pencil sharpener
- ___ scissors, good quality
- ___ pencil pouch or box to hold materials

- ___ basic function calculator (for science)
- ___ One eight pack of AAA batteries (for scientific calculators in math)
- ___ 12" English/metric ruler
- ___ compass with a stable hinge that won't slip! (like an engineering compass)
- ___ protractor (smaller is better)
- ___ 1 box of tissues for student use to give to your first period teacher

- ___ For **HOME**: a dictionary & thesaurus in book form (American Heritage paperbacks are great)
